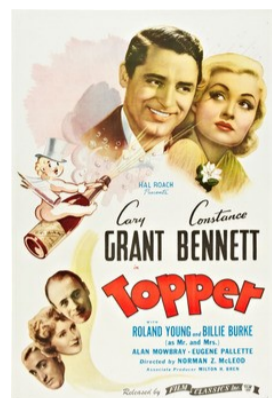

**Art Deco Festival: The Gay Divorcée (1934)** (107mins) PG Parental Guidance recommended

What's a girl to do if she wants a divorce from her estranged husband in 1934? Well if you're Ginger Rogers, you hire a lawyer who comes up with the cunning plan of having you caught in a pretend extramarital affair at an elegant English seaside hotel. But Mimi (Rogers) didn't expect dashing dancer Guy (Fred Astaire) to enter the picture, whom she promptly mistakes for her partner in crime. **Special prices apply.**



**Art Deco Festival: Topper (1937)** (96mins) PG Parental Guidance recommended

One car crash on a winding forest road, and carefree and glamorous couple George (Cary Grant) and Marion (Constance Bennett) find themselves deceased. Confined to an existence as ghosts, they need to do a good deed in order to get into heaven. Who better to haunt than their old, stuffy friend Cosmo Topper (Roland Young) who is trapped in a difficult marriage and a boring job? **Special prices apply.**



**Ben Is Back (103mins)** M Suitable for Mature Audiences: Offensive language

BEN IS BACK follows the charming yet troubled Ben Burns (Lucas Hedges), who returns home to his unsuspecting family one fateful Christmas Eve. Ben's wary mother Holly (Julia Roberts) welcomes her son's return, but soon learns he is still very much in harm's way. During the 24 hours that may change their lives forever, Holly must do everything in her power to avoid the family's downfall.



**Green Book (130mins)** M Suitable for Mature Audiences: Offensive language

When Italian-American bouncer Tony Lip (Viggo Mortensen) is hired to drive Dr. Don Shirley (Mahershala Ali), a world-class black pianist, on a concert tour to the Deep South, they must rely on "The Green Book" to guide them to the few establishments that were then safe for African-Americans. Confronted with racism, danger, as well as unexpected humanity and humour, they are forced to set aside differences to survive.



**Mary Queen Of Scots (124mins)** R13 Restricted to persons 13 & over: Violence, sexual violence, sex scenes **FINAL**

MARY QUEEN OF SCOTS explores the turbulent life of Mary Stuart (Saoirse Ronan). Queen of France at 16, Mary returns to her native Scotland to reclaim her rightful throne. But Scotland and England fall under the rule of Elizabeth I (Margot Robbie). When Mary asserts her claim to the English throne, threatening Elizabeth's sovereignty, betrayal and conspiracies within each court imperil both thrones – and change the course of history.



**On The Basis Of Sex (120mins)** M Suitable for Mature Audiences: Offensive language

ON THE BASIS OF SEX tells the inspiring true story of Ruth Bader Ginsberg (Felicity Jones), and charts Ruth's heroic journey as she becomes one of the first women to attend Harvard Law School, raises a family alongside her loving husband Marty (Armie Hammer), and brings a case before the US Supreme Court in an effort to overturn more than a century of gender discrimination and in order to become a U.S. Supreme Court Justice.
