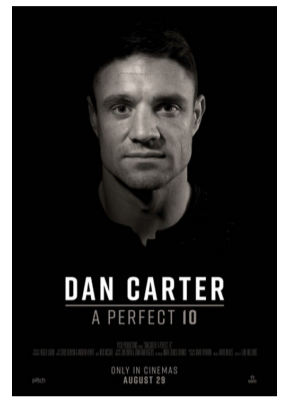


**2040 (92mins)**

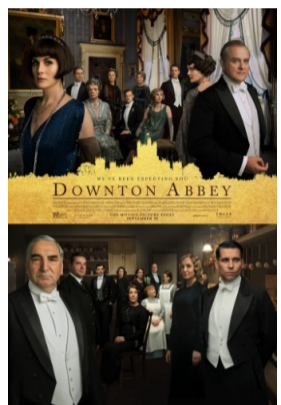


**Dan Carter: A Perfect 10 (91mins)**

THE KEEPER tells the true love story between young English woman Margaret Friar (Freya Mavor) and German PoW Bert Trautmann (David Kross). Meeting at the end of WW2 in a PoW camp, Margaret's father notices Bert's prowess as a goal-keeper and gets him to play for his team.



**The Kitchen (102mins)**

Restricted to Persons 16 & over: Violence, domestic violence, offensive language

THE KITCHEN stars Melissa McCarthy, Tiffany Haddish and Elisabeth Moss as three 1978 Hell's Kitchen housewives whose mobster husbands are sent to prison by the FBI. Left with little but a sharp ax to grind, the ladies take the Irish mafia's matters into their own hands.



**Late Night (102mins)**

**Once Upon A Time In Hollywood (141mins)**

Graphic violence, drug use, offensive language, sexual material

Quentin Tarantino's ONCE UPON A TIME IN HOLLYWOOD visits 1969 Los Angeles, where everything is changing, as TV star Rick Dalton (Leonardo DiCaprio) and his long time stunt double Cliff Booth (Brad Pitt) make their way around an industry they hardly recognize anymore. A tribute to the final moments of Hollywood's golden age.
