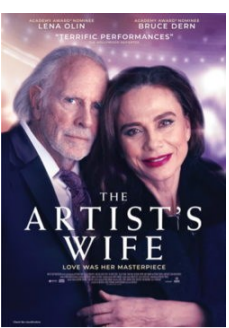

**The Artist's Wife** (95 mins) M Suitable for Mature Audiences: Nudity, offensive language, sexual content

Claire (Lena Olin) is the wife of celebrated artist Richard Smythson (Bruce Dern). Once a promising painter herself, Claire now lives in the shadow of her husband's career. When he is diagnosed with dementia, she shields his condition from the art community.



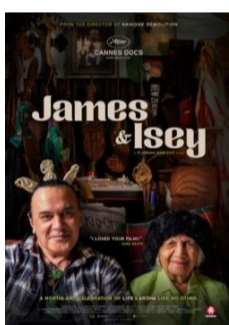
**Days Of The Bagnold Summer** (86 mins) M Suitable for Mature Audiences: Offensive language **NEW**

Funny, charming and wince-inducingly accurate, this British comedy sweetly draws you into the wobbly relationship between well-intentioned single librarian Sue Bagnold and her black-clad teenage son Daniel, who is stuck with Mum for the summer holidays.



**Dream Horse** (113 mins) PG Parental Guidance recommended: Coarse language, sexual references

The inspiring true story of Dream Alliance, an unlikely racehorse bred by small town bartender Jan Vokes (Toni Collette). With little money and no experience, Jan convinces her neighbours to chip in to help raise Dream and compete with the racing elites.



**James & Isey** (92 mins) M Suitable for Mature Audiences: Offensive language **FINAL**

99-year-old Isey lives with her adult son James on their small farm in Kawakawa. Isey is turning 100 in a week. In their unique relationship, James has devoted the last 20 years to looking after his mum. A joyous celebration of the sacred and everyday aroha.



**June Again** (99 mins) M Suitable for Mature Audiences: Offensive language

A twist of fate gives family matriarch June (Noni Hazlehurst) a reprieve from a debilitating illness. With plenty of pluck and much to her adult children's amazement, she sets about trying to put their lives back on track.



**Poppy** (98 mins) PG Parental Guidance recommended: Offensive language, sexual references

Poppy, a young woman with Down syndrome, refuses to be defined by disability and takes control of her own life. Poppy's ambition to become a motor mechanic is stalled by her protective brother—until she teams up with an old school friend.



**Six Minutes To Midnight** (100 mins) M Suitable for Mature Audiences: Violence **FINAL**

In summer 1939, Thomas Miller (Eddie Izzard) takes on a role teaching English to the daughters of high-ranking Nazis. When the body of a former teacher is discovered, Thomas has to run from the police with the threat of being hanged for murder.
