Spy thriller THE 355 unites a dream team of formidable female stars. When a top-secret weapon falls into mercenary hands, wild card CIA agent Mason Brown (Jessica Chastain) joins forces with rival German agent Marie (Diane Kruger), former MI6 ally Khadijah (Lupita Nyong'o), and skilled Colombian psychologist Graciela (Penélope Cruz) on a lethal mission to retrieve it.



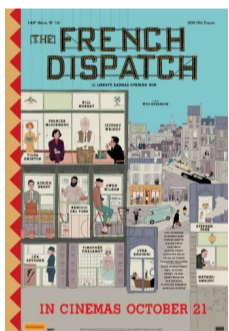
**Best Sellers** (102 mins) **M** Suitable for Mature Audiences: Offensive language

**House Of Gucci** (158 mins) **R13** Restricted: Violence, offensive language, sex scenes

HOUSE OF GUCCI is inspired by the scandalous true story of the glamorous family empire behind the Italian fashion house. Patrizia Reggiani (Lady Gaga) is married to Maurizio Gucci (Adam Driver), one of the heirs to the Gucci company.
