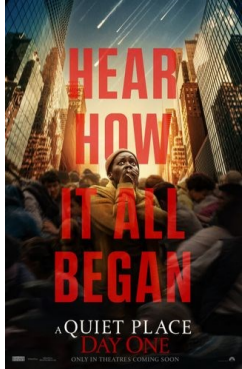

## **A Quiet Place: Day One** (100 mins)

**M** Mature Audience: Violence, offensive language

Experience the day the world went quiet. Set in NYC on the first day of an alien invasion, a woman (Lupita Nyong'o) must navigate her way through a city gripped by fear with the help of a mismatched group of survivors.



## **Fly Me To The Moon** (132 mins)

**M** Mature Audience: Offensive language **NEW**

A stylish comedy set against the Apollo 11 moon landing. Brought in to fix NASA's public image, marketing maven Kelly Jones (Scarlett Johansson) wreaks havoc on launch director Cole Davis's (Channing Tatum) task. When the mission is deemed too important to fail, Jones is directed to stage a fake moon landing as back-up.



## **Ka Whawhai Tonu** (115 mins) **M** Mature: Violence, offensive language, content may disturb **subtitled**

Set in 1864, KA WHAWHAI TONU tells the story of the battle of O Rākau, fought with impossible odds between Māori and the colonial forces. Two young teenagers are forced to take control of their own destiny amidst the chaos of the battle.



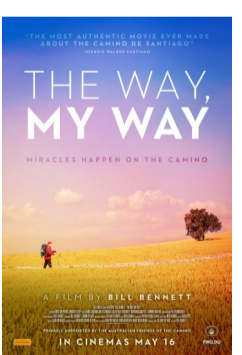
## **The Bikeriders** (116 mins) **R13** Restricted: Violence, offensive language, drug use, sexual material

THE BIKERIDERS follows the rise of a 1960s Midwestern motorcycle club through the lives of its members. Kathy (Jodie Comer), married to reckless Benny (Austin Butler), recounts the Vandals' evolution, beginning as a club of outsiders united by good times, rumbling bikes, and respect for their steadfast leader Johnny (Tom Hardy).



## **The Taste Of Things** (135 mins) **PG** Parental Guidance: Nudity **subtitled**

Esteemed cook Eugenie (Juliette Binoche) has been working for 20 years for famous gourmet Dodin (Benoit Magimel). Their bond turns into a romance, but when Dodin notices Eugenie's reluctance to commit to him, he decides to start cooking for her.



## **The Way, My Way** (100 mins) **PG** Parental Guidance: Coarse language **FINAL**

Based on Bill Bennett's best-selling memoir of the same name. THE WAY, MY WAY is the charming true story of a stubborn Australian man who decides to walk the 800-kilometre-long Camino de Santiago pilgrimage route through Spain. He doesn't know why he's doing it... but it will change him forever.
