Beetlejuice Beetlejuice (105 mins) M Violence, offensive language, horror, content may offend Beetlejuice (Micheal Keaton) is back! After an unexpected family tragedy, three generations of the Deetz family return to Winter River. Still haunted, Lydia's (Winona Ryder) life is turned upside down when her rebellious teenage daughter Astrid accidentally opens the portal to the Afterlife. Directed by Tim Burton.



Blink Twice (102 mins) R16 Restricted: Brutal violence, rape, drug use, offensive language FINAL When tech billionaire Slater King (Channing Tatum) meets waitress Frida (Naomi Ackie) at a gala, he invites her to join him on a dream vacation on his private island where everyone's having a great time—until they're not. Directed by Zoe Kravitz.



The Fabulous Four (99 mins) M Mature Audience: Offensive language, sexual references, drug use FINAL Three lifelong friends travel to Florida to be bridesmaids at their college friend's (Bette Midler) wedding. Sisterhoods are rekindled, the past rises up again, and there's enough sparks, drinks and romance to change their lives forever.




Mr Blake At Your Service (110 mins) PG Coarse Language subtitled

In a twist of fate, charming British businessman Andrew Blake (John Malkovich) becomes the butler of a once-distinguished French manor house, owned by the elegant yet aloof Madame de Beauvilier (Fanny Ardant) who has fallen on hard times.



Midas Man (112 mins) **M** Mature Audience: Violence, offensive language, drug use **NEW** Midas Man is a biographical film about the life of music entrepreneur Brian Epstein, who managed The Beatles. The film tracks how Epstein rose to prominence by managing a series of popular artists including The Beatles, Cilla Black and Gerry & The Pacemakers before his sudden death in 1967 at the age of 32.
